<b>Apologies for Absence</b>	None
<b>Minutes:</b>	The Minutes of the previous Meeting were approved
<b>Matters Arising from the Minutes</b>	<b>Church Road</b> : The Application to build houses on the site of Cooper's Scrapyard may have to be re-submitted as there was no time limit attached to the Approval. <b>Western Farm</b> : The proposal to make a new entrance was under review; there may be a need to move the office block <b>Station Road</b> : An application to erect a bungalow on land in front of number 26 had been Refused
<b>Speed Limit Signs</b>	The Chairman had made further enquiries into the cost of active signs; the initial package would be £3089 which would include 2 batteries and posts and brackets; replacement batteries would cost £80 per set at today's prices. A grant of £1500 could be obtained from the Norfolk Communities Fund and a further grant could be obtained from Beverley Spratt, our District Councillor. Four volunteers had offered to move the single sign monthly and exchange the battery for a fully charged one approximately two weekly. The Clerk agreed to check the insurance position of the volunteers and it was also noted that a hi-vis jacket would be needed for protection. The question of weight was raised and this would be checked out. Members agreed that an application should be made with a view to continuing with the project
